New Patient Registrations

Due to planning restrictions implemented when we moved to our current site at Rodney Road, we are unable to have more than 13,500 patients registered with us. For the practice to receive further funding, allowing us to develop and offer new services, we must be able to increase the numbers registered with us. We are in the process of submitting a planning application to Elmbridge to ask for this cap to be lifted to 16,500 and we will keep you updated with any progress.

CAB GP Outreach Programme

In Jan 2024 Citizens Advice launched their first GP outreach location at the surgery. They can help with any issue spanning debt, employment and benefits entitlement, to consumer and housing issues.
